Community Healing Center Gives Hope to Traumatized Youth

Recently, we opened the community Healing Center taking residence at the Boys & Girls Club - Stenstrom Unit. This center is a vital resource for reducing violent crime at the source. City data shows that 60-70% of youth arrested for violent crime over the past five years have lived in a household where they were exposed to physical or sexual violence. This is not going to turn crime around tomorrow. We have other initiatives that are doing that in our portfolio. This is a long-term strategy that is crime prevention, but also hope building.

#### **Funding for Domestic Violence Survivors**

Thanks to funding from the Illinois Department of Commerce & Economic Opportunity secured by Illinois State Sen. Steve Stadelman, victims of domestic abuse will soon benefit from additional resources at UW Health Northern Illinois. The grant enables the hiring of two additional staff to work in the emergency department, offering support and resources to patients who are victims of domestic abuse or strangulation. It will also support educational and training opportunities for staff, awareness campaigns in the community and additional resources for patients.



# **Whitman Street Reconfiguration**

Rockford will receive a \$7.1 million in federal funding from a Reconnecting Communities Grant to reconfigure the city's Whitman Street Interchange and reconnect neighborhoods that have been isolated for decades by one-way streets, bridges and ramps. This project will provide better access for EMS and others from west of the Rock River to UW Health SwedishAmerican Hospital and the broader East State Street commercial corridor. 


## **Spring Brings... Potholes?**


