

### **Drop in Violent Crime for Second Straight Year**

I am proud of the progress we are making in reducing crime in Rockford and our efforts to stop the cycle of violence that has plagued us for decades.

We have seen a 29% reduction in property crime and a 34% decrease in violent crime since 2016. We also have concrete programs, with measurable results, providing hope, opportunities and resources to assist youth impacted by trauma.

# SmartStart Program Is Smart for Rockford's Kids

Rockford recently hosted Governor Pritzker to discuss the success of the SmartStart Illinois program. The multi-year plan gives kids across the state access to early education, increases funding for childcare providers, and offers families support and resources, eliminating "preschool deserts" where no early childhood programs exist. The program allows us to wrap our community in our hands and hearts, so we can get our youngest citizens on the right track, and they can be their best selves, which makes our community better.



#### We're On A Roll


