# **Concrete Workforce Development Program to Help with SIFI Deal**

For the last two years, Rockford has partnered with LT Construction to build more than two miles of sidewalk, provide training to our young people and connect them to the trades. This year, program participants will help IBEW Local 196 lay fiber optic cable in front of every home, business and organization thanks to the City's development agreement with SIFI. This is a nearly \$300 million project that will benefit residents and now benefit these young people with an opportunity for a career!

#### **Excel Center Success**

The City recently allocated \$600,000 to Goodwill Northern Illinois to support the development of an Excel Center in the former Gustafson's Furniture space in the North Towne Mall. The Excel Center is a free Adult High School where students can obtain a high school diploma, workforce training and dual credits while offering free childcare and other support services. It is a model with proven success in more than 37 schools around the country.
