Road Improvements Coming to a Neighborhood Near You

City Council voted to invest an additional \$15.5M in infrastructure from our budget surplus including:


- Improve neighborhood streets, sidewalks and alleys by boosting neighborhood funding in 2025 for every ward in the city by 78%.
- 2. Resurface Alpine Road from Spring Creek to Highcrest.
- 3. Resurface Mulford Road from Fincham to Guilford and Gale to Churchview.
- 4. Resurface Spring Creek Road from Welsh to Mulford.
- 5. Resurface Riverside Blvd. from Rockton to Latham.



Domestic Violence Awareness Month

Domestic violence accounts for 40-50% of our violent crime. Additionally, 60-70% of youth committing violent crimes have documented exposure to domestic and/or sexual violence. Survivors or witnesses of domestic violence and

other violent crime are at increased risk of mental health issues. The Violence Prevention Coordinating Council works with the Family Peace Center to lower the violent crime rate in Rockford and set our children up for success. Statistics show it's working.



Rancho Supermarket Grocery Store Coming to Kishwaukee and Broadway

Too many areas of our city lack a convenient grocery store. That's why our Community and Economic Development Department team helped Rancho Supermarket apply for and secure a \$2.1 million state grant. That grant will help open the new grocery store at the intersection of Kishwaukee and Broadway in Rockford. Rancho Supermarket, a full service grocery store, will offer fresh produce, a deli, bakery and hot foods and is expected to open in the spring of 2025. The City will continue exploring ways to bring more grocery stores to other food deserts in the community.



Faith and Blue

Congratulations to Winnebago County Sheriff Gary Caruana, Rockford Park District Police Chief Theo Glover and Rockford Police Chief Carla Redd for being recognized for their impact on our community at the recent Faith and Blue, a national event to bring the faith community and law enforcement together. All three law enforcement agencies work together, resulting in a 34% reduction in violent crime in Rockford since 2017.
