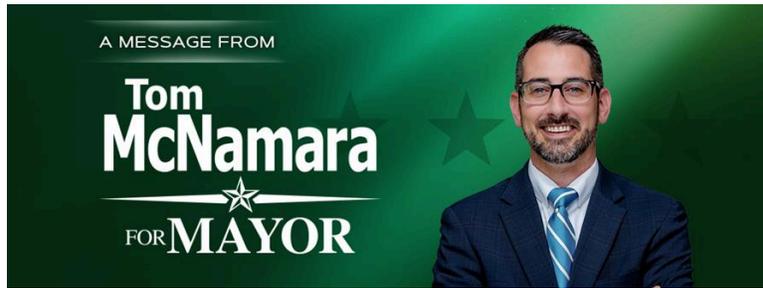

15th Avenue Glow Up

The City of Rockford will receive more than \$17 million to replace the 15th Avenue Bridge.
